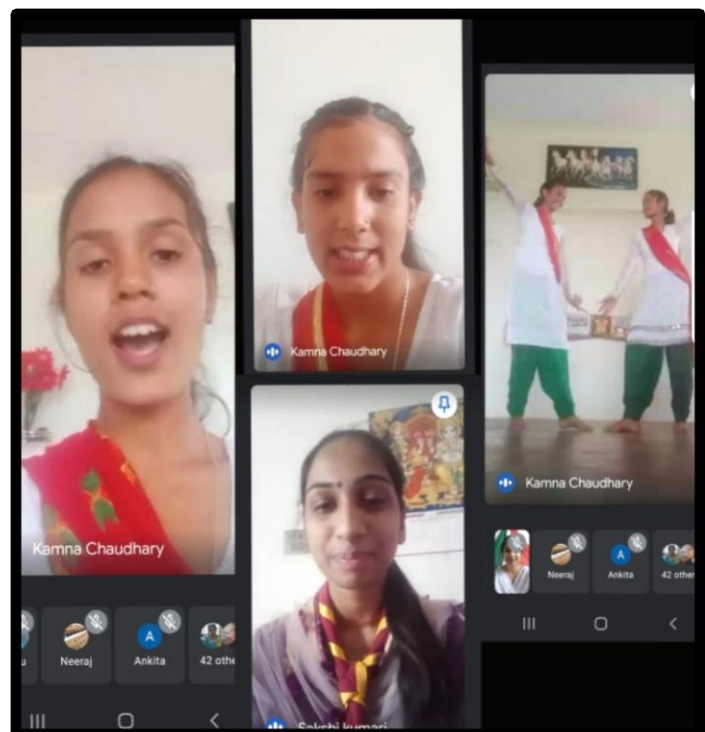


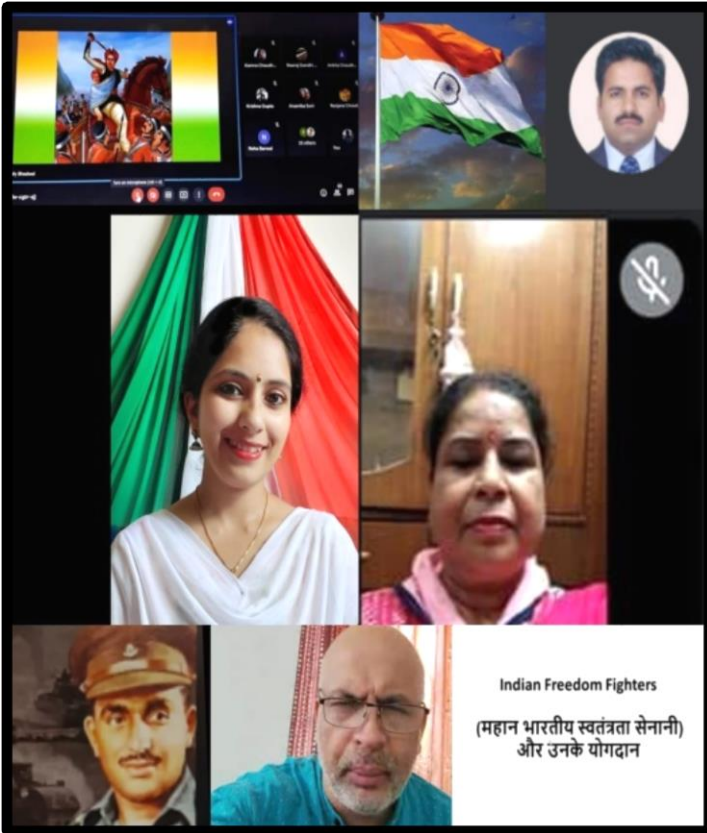

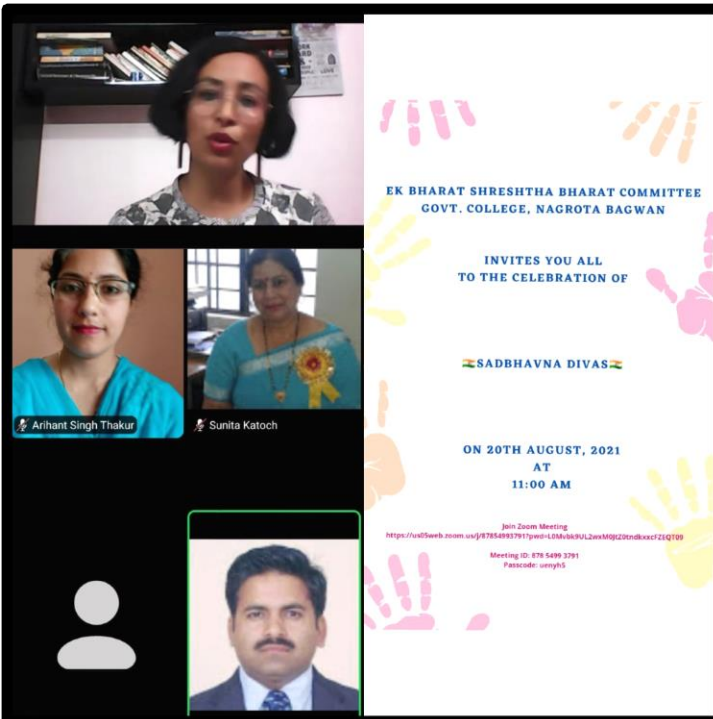

इकाई ने स्वच्छता अभियान चलाया



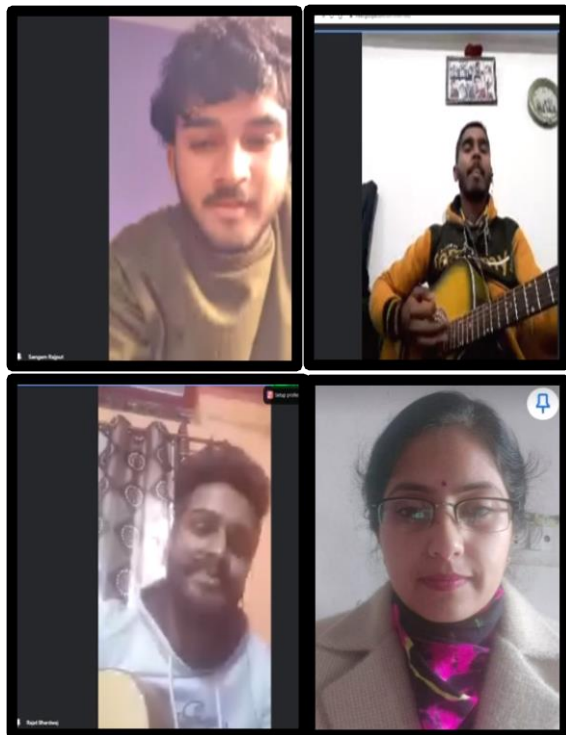
