58.00 per cent of the respondents agreed that Teacher's Effectiveness (in terms of subject clarity, teaching methods etc.) was excellent, while 34.00 per cent of the respondents acceded that Teacher's Effectiveness (in terms of subject clarity, teaching methods etc.) was very good. However, only 4.00 per cent of the respondents agreed that Teacher's Effectiveness (in terms of subject clarity, teaching methods etc.) was good and satisfactory respectively.
2. Infrastructure facilities in the college (in terms of classroom, laboratories, library, waters system etc.)

29.00 per cent of the respondents agreed that Infrastructure facilities in the college (in terms of classroom, laboratories, library, waters system etc.) were excellent, while 50.00 per cent of the respondents were of the view that Infrastructure facilities in the college (in terms of classroom, laboratories, library, waters system etc.) were very good. However, only 17.00 per cent and 4.00 percent of the respondents agreed that that Infrastructure facilities in the college (in terms of classroom, laboratories, library, waters system etc.) were good and satisfactory respectively.

## 3. Counseling and mentoring support from teachers


42.00 per cent of the respondents agreed that Counseling and mentoring support from teachers were excellent, while 35.00 per cent of the respondents agreed that Counseling and mentoring support from teachers were very good. However, only
13.00 per cent and 10.00 percent of the respondents agreed that that Counseling and mentoring support from teachers were good and satisfactory respectively.

## 4. Co-curricular activities support etc.


21.00 per cent of the respondents agreed that Co-curricular activities support etc. was excellent, while 46.00 per cent of the respondents agreed that that Cocurricular activities support etc. was very good. However, only 23.00 per cent, 6.00 per cent and 4.00 per cent of the respondents agreed that that Co-curricular activities support etc. was good, satisfactory and poor respectively.

## 5. Co-operation by the administrative staff


27.00 per cent of the respondents agreed that co-operation by the administrative staff was excellent, while 56.00 per cent of the respondents agreed that cooperation by the administrative staff was very good. However, only 11.00 per cent,
