Conducted By IQAC Cell- Government College Nagrota Bagwan

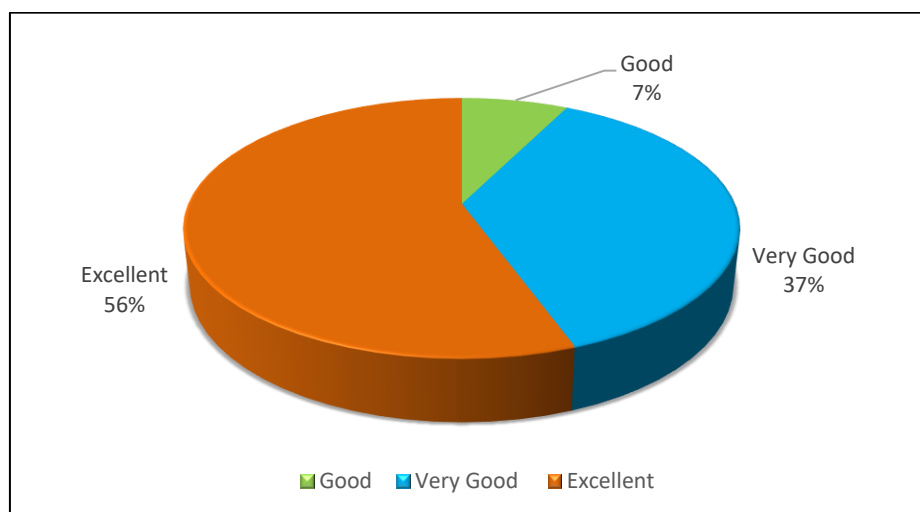

Keeping this in mind, a separate questionnaire is prepared for feedback from the students. The detailed analysis of this feedback is as follows;

1. Syllabus is Need Based



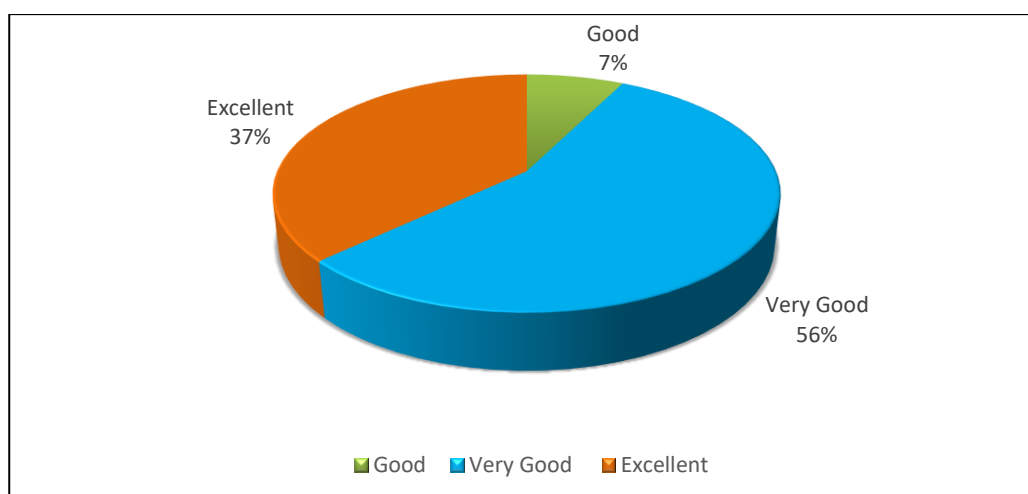
44 per cent of the respondents responded excellent that syllabus is need based while 52 percent of the respondents rated very good for this view. 4 per cent termed it as good whereas 0 per cent rated satisfactory and poor for this view respectively.

2. Aims and Objectives of the Syllabus are Well Defined and Clear to Teachers and Students



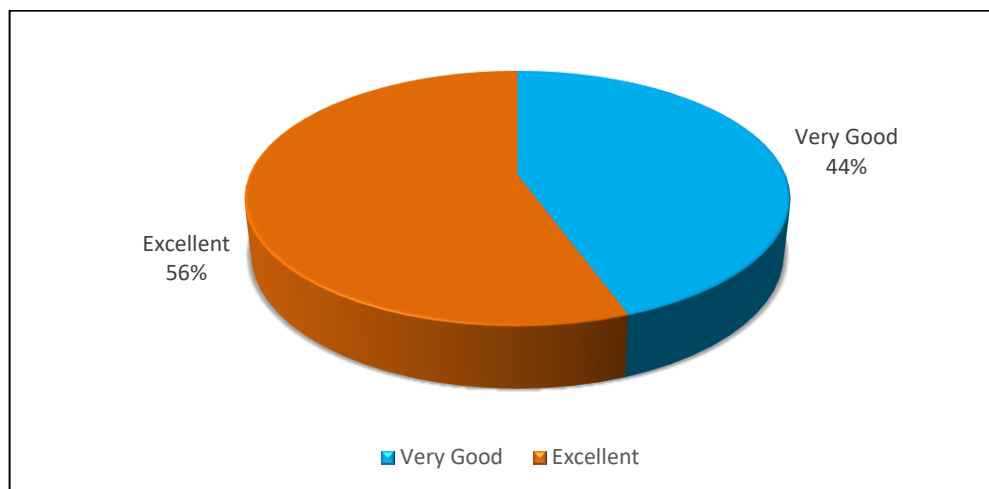
56 per cent of the respondents rated that aims and objectives of the syllabus are well defined and clear to teachers and students as excellent. 37 per cent of the respondents rated this view as very good. 7 per cent rated this as good whereas 0 per cent were of the view as satisfactory and poor respectively.

3. Sufficient Number of Prescribed Books are Available to the Library



37 Per cent of the respondents rated sufficient number of prescribed books available in the library as excellent while 56 per cent of the respondents agreed to this view as very good. 7 per cent rated this view as good and 0 per cent rated it as satisfactory and poor.

4. The Course/Syllabus of this Subject Increased My Knowledge and Perspective in the Subject Area



56 per cent of the respondents rated the course/syllabus of this subject increased their knowledge and perspective in the subject as excellent while 44 per cent rated this view as very good. 0 per cent was rated as good, satisfactory, and poor respectively.

5. The Course of Studies Carries Sufficient Number of Optional Papers and Books Prescribed as Reference Materials are Relevant and Appropriate



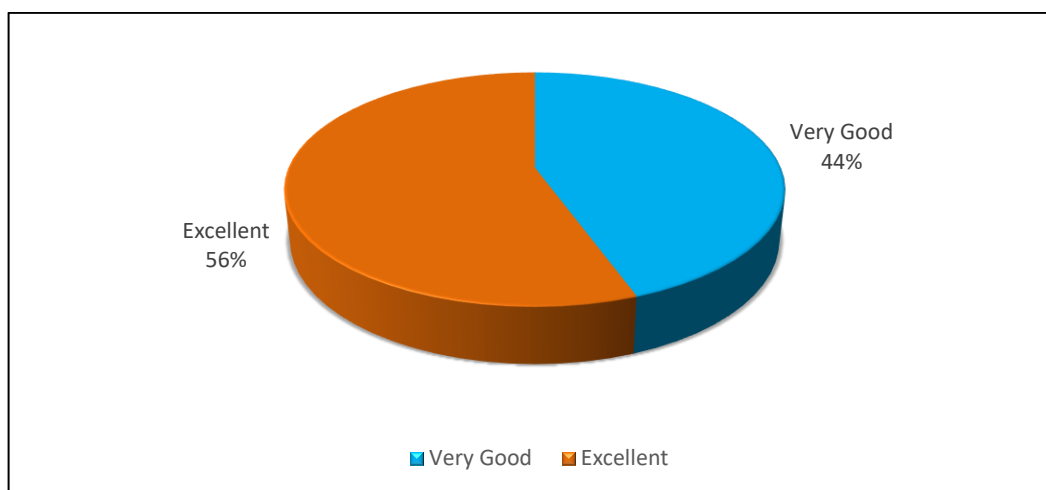
45 per cent of the respondents were of the view that the course of studies carries sufficient number of optional papers and books prescribed as reference materials are relevant and appropriate as excellent, 48 per cent as very good and 7 per cent as good.

6. Infrastructural Facilities, Such as Teacher's Rooms/ Carrels, Class Rooms, Reading Rooms and Toilets are Available in the Department



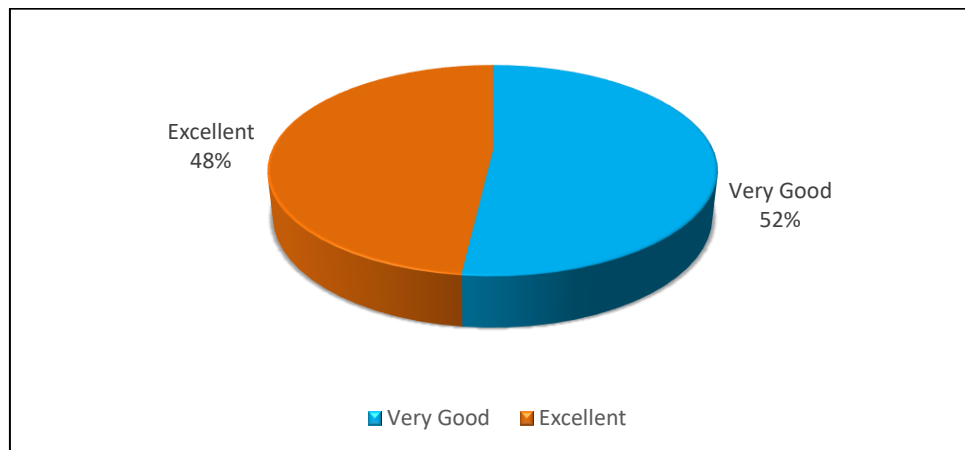
30 per cent of the respondents agreed that infrastructural facilities, such as teacher's rooms/carrels, class rooms, reading rooms and toilets available in the department are excellent while 44 per cent termed it as very good. 22 per cent of the respondents were of the view that infrastructure facilities for teachers are good whereas 4 percent rated this criterion as satisfactory. 0 per cent rated it as poor.

7. Tests and Examinations are Conducted Well in Time with Proper Coverage of All Units in the Syllabus.



56 per cent of the respondents acceded that tests and examination are conducted well in time with proper coverage of all units in the syllabus and rated it as excellent. 44 per cent rated it as very good.

8. Provisions for Professional Development are Non-Discriminatory & Fair




48 per cent of the respondents rated provisions for professional development are non- discriminatory and fair as excellent while 52 per cent rated this criterion as very good.

9. Staff canteen is available at the college easily.



52 per cent of the respondents rated that college canteen available at college easily as excellent while 41 per cent rated this as very good. 4 per cent of the respondents termed it as good whereas 3 per cent rated it as satisfactory.


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
