Menstrual Hygiene Day is an annual awareness day which is observed on 28th May to highlight the important of good menstrual hygiene management. With the purpose of breaking taboos and ending stigma surrounding menstruation, the Red Ribbon Club of the college organized an awareness lecture for the female students of the college. The lecture was delivered by Dr. Shelly Parul Bhadwal, Nodal Officer, Red Ribbon Club, Nearly 50 students of post-graduate classes attended the lecture. Additionally, a poster regarding menstrual hygiene was installed in the girls' washroom to spread awareness about this issue.



The Red Ribbon Club of Govt. College Nagrota Bagwan along with the health officials of Govt. Hospital, Nagrota Bagwan, organized a **One-day Vaccination Camp**on 6th August, 2022 to provide booster vaccines for COVID-19 to the students, teachers and non-teaching

Apart from college teachers, non-teaching staff and students, residents of nearby villages also benefitted from the camp. In order to encourage the engagement of youth in matters of society and nation, Red Ribbon Club organized a motivational lecture on 12th August. Nearly 60 students attended the event. This event was part of the ongoing National Nutrition Month.



The Red Ribbon Club of the college along with the NSS Unit organized an **Awareness lecture on Eye Donation** on 9th September, 2022. The National Eye Donation Fortnight is observed every year from 25th August to 8th September every year. Dr. Gaurav Sharma, Associate Professor, Department of Ophthalmology, RPGMC, Tanda was the invited speaker for the event. His lecture served as a myth-buster regarding eye donation. He motivated the students to pledge their eyes for donation after death and help someone see the world through their eyes.
