Happiness Programme

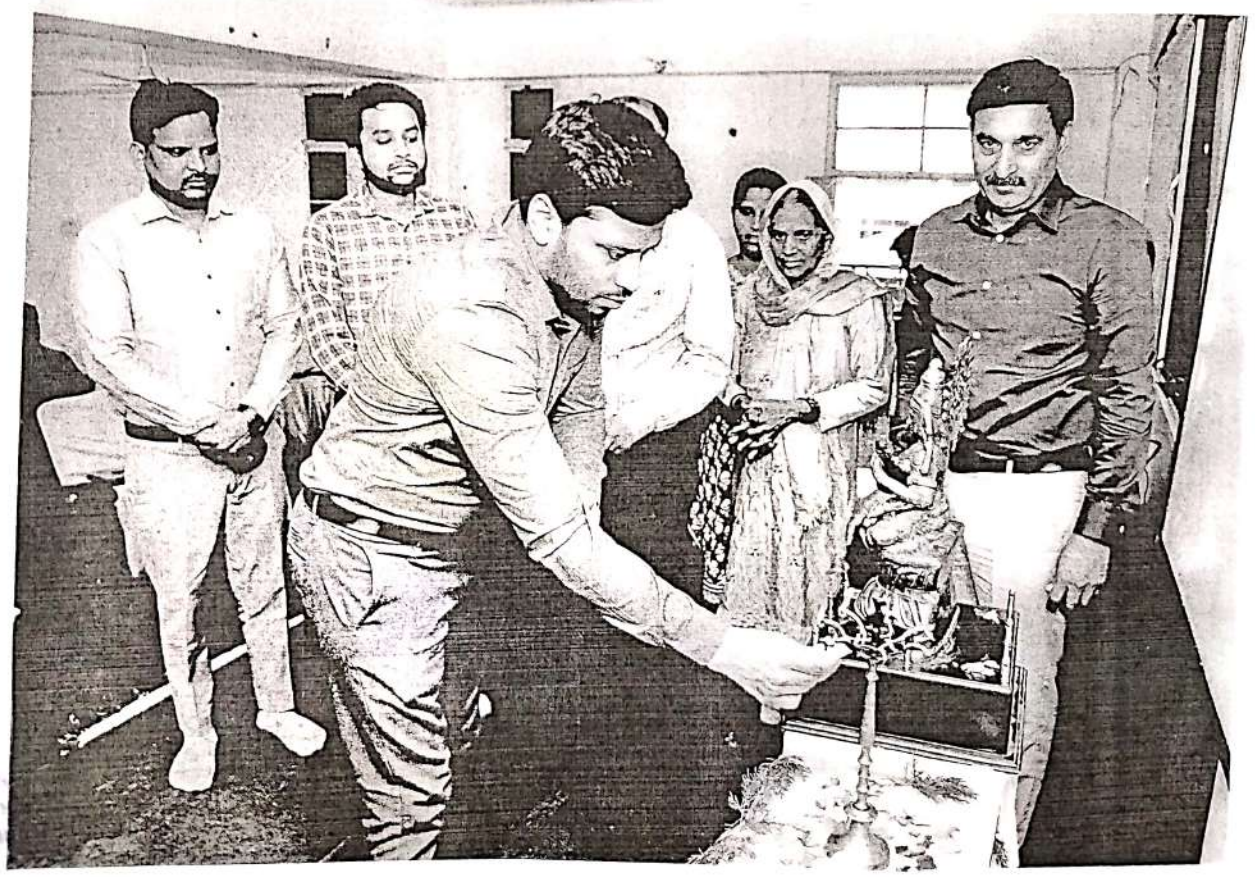
