

# Awareness Lecture on the Ill Effects of Drugs, Organized

Nagrota Bagwan: An awareness lecture on the ill effects of drugs was organized under the aegis of the the career counseling Cell at Government Degree College, Nagrota Bagwan. The program commenced with the lighting of the ceremonial lamp by the college principal, Dr. Surender Kumar Soni. In his welcome address, he emphasized the importance of protecting the youth from drugs for the bright future of society and the nation. The chief guest of the event, Sub-Divisional Magistrate (SDM) Mr. Munish Sharma, addressed the students, expressing concern over the increasing prevalence of drug abuse in society. He specifically highlighted the growing use of synthetic drugs as a serious threat to society, warning that if this trend is not curbed in time, every family could be affected. He urged the students to stay away from drugs and spread awareness about their harmful effects. 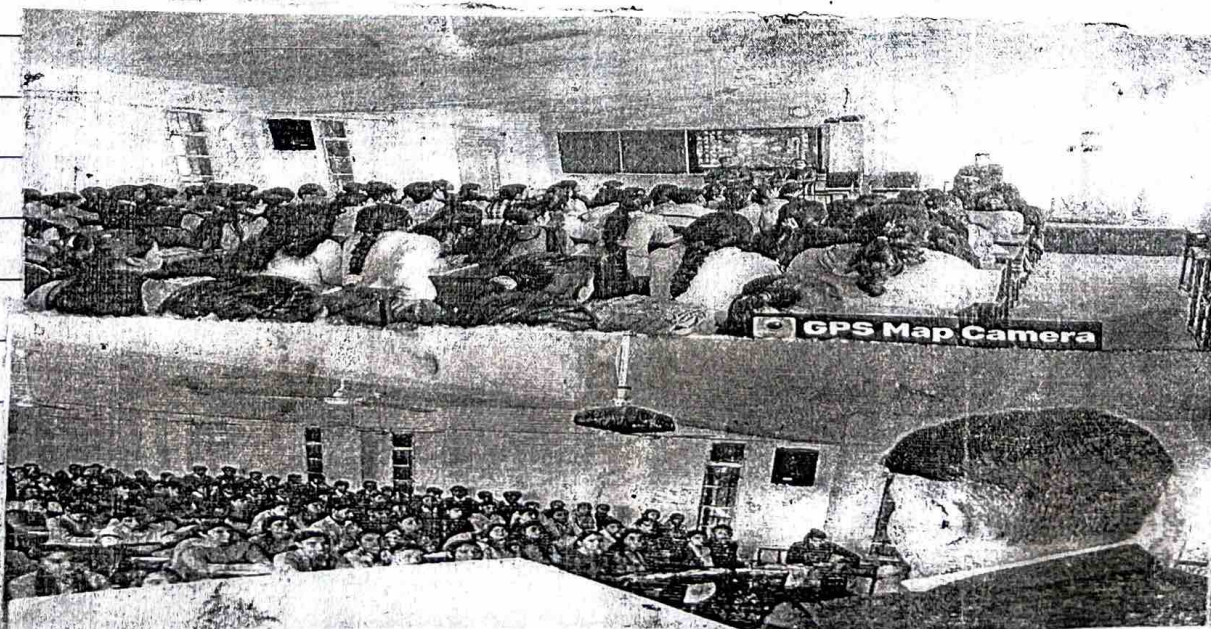

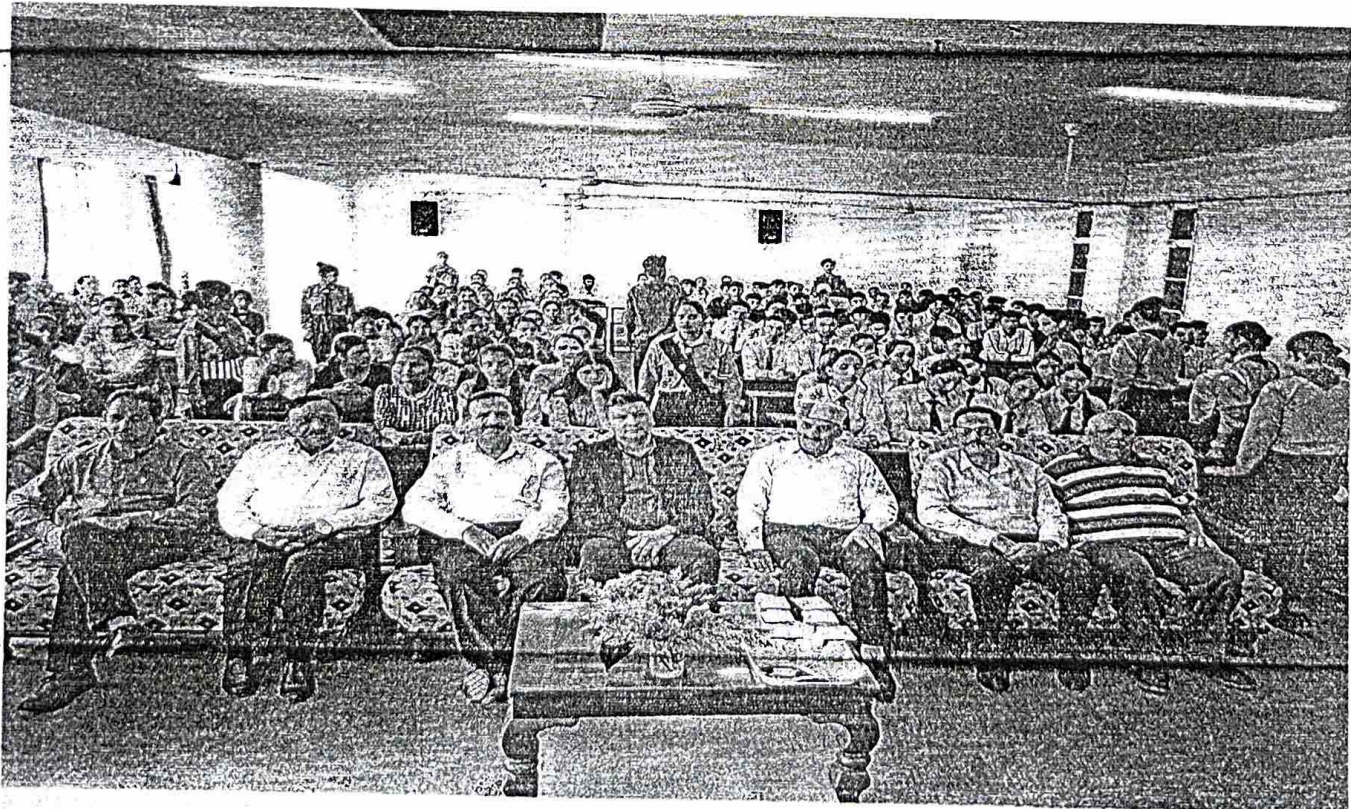



## Report Of the Event /Activity

### Anti-Drug Program Organized at Government Excellence College, Nagrota Bagwan

Nagrota Bagwan: A special program on drug prevention was organized today at Government College, Nagrota Bagwan. The event was inaugurated by Principal Dr. S.K. Soni, who welcomed the chief guest, Mr. Hitesh Lakhanpal, Additional Superintendent of Police, Kangra, and other distinguished guests. He stated that the college has always been committed to bringing positive changes in society, and such awareness programs are a significant step in that direction. The program aimed to educate students about the harmful effects of drug abuse and raise awareness against it. The chief guest, Additional Superintendent of Police, Kangra, Mr. Hitesh Lakhanpal, spoke in detail about the adverse effects of drug addiction on the lives of young people. He emphasized that drug abuse not only harms an individual's physical and mental health but also severely impacts their social and family life. He urged the youth to stay away from drugs and spread awareness among those around them. Mr. Lakhanpal highlighted that initially, people are lured into drug use for free, but eventually, they spend their money, resort to theft, and fall into addiction. The special guest, former principal Mr. Ram Pal Chopra, expressed his joy by sharing his memories as the first principal of this college. He mentioned that when the college was established, there were only 110 students, whereas today, the strength has grown to over 3,000. The college now offers postgraduate courses as well as BBA and BCA programs. Prof. Chopra advised students to remain focused and avoid the misguided path of drug abuse, reminding them of the sacrifices their parents make, often taking loans, to support their education. He warned that indulging in drug addiction would destroy their parents' dreams. The program was attended by Principal Dr. S.K. Soni, former principals Mr. Ram Pal Chopra, Mr. K.S. Atri, and Mr. Pradeep Chaudhary, along with faculty members such as Subhash Verma, Parjesh Malli, Red Ribbon Coordinator Dr. Madhavi Parashar, Dr. Manjeet Singh, Dr. Nipunika Rana, Dr. Rajeev Kumar, and others.
