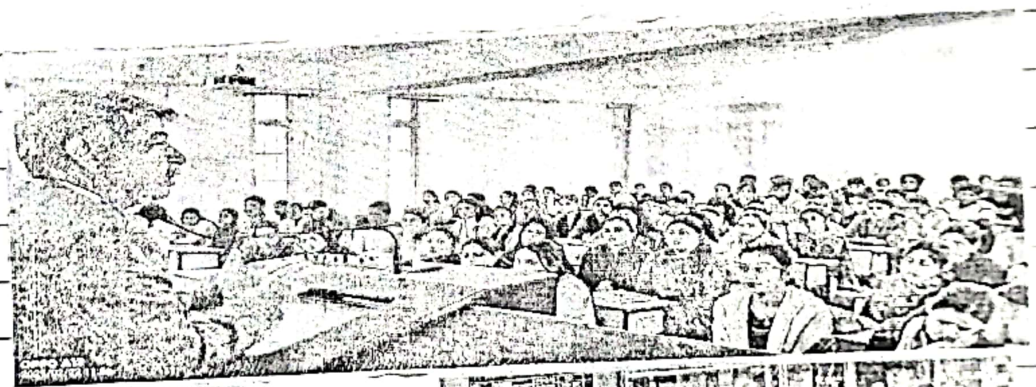


# Workshop on Agropreneurship Organized Government Excellence College, Nagrota Bagwan
