



Action Taken Report

A meeting of IQAC was held on 21st Sept. 2024 in the office of the Principal. The meeting was convened by IQAC coordinator Prof. Saini Sagar. The following members remained present in the meeting :-

Minutes of the meeting :

The meeting was held to assess the action taken on the proposals made by the IQAC in the last meeting of the previous session held on 15th May 2024. IQAC verified that the following actions were carried out and the proposed plans executed :-

1. The admission process for admission to various courses, for various classes at UG and PG level, along with self-finance courses was successfully carried out.
2. It was a matter of immense pride for the institution that 19 students of BBA and BCA, freshly passed out in the session 2023-24, got

- placements in reputed companies like NCC Global Multinational Company Mahuli & Value for Seller Pvt Limited, Sahar. Initially, a total no. of 68 students cleared the written examination conducted by the companies. Later on the basis of interview, 19 got selected for jobs with the annual package of Rs 2.5 lakh to Rs 5 lakh each.
3. With a view to inculcate & encourage the sports spirit in students, an inter-department three-day cricket match was organised between Dept. of BBA & BCA, in the college ground from 25-05-24 to 27-05-24. College Principal Dr. S. K. Soni was the Chief Guest. The team of BBA Dept. emerged victorious in the match. Ajit Kumar of BBA was adjudged 'Man of the match'.
 4. To keep abreast with the latest web-based trends adopted in teaching with the availability of Information & Communication Technology, a two-day State Level Workshop was organised in college by the Dept. of Physics under the aegis of IIT, Delhi on 14-6-24 & 15-6-24, on the subject 'Virtual Labs'. This workshop proved to be a milestone in providing essential knowledge in using various IT tool of learning like additional web resources, video-lectures, animated demonstrations & self evaluation. The workshop provided hands-on experience of remote experimentation through virtual labs to teachers as well as students.
 5. It was a matter of immense pride for the college that Radhika Sharma, student of B.Sc. IT (my Zombi) bagged, 6th position in the merit list of HPLI, 11 marks out of 200.

6. To provide ample job opportunities to the unemployed & also to the outgoing students of the college a 'Job Fair' was organised in the college by the joint collaboration of Dept. of Employment & Local administration, Nagrata Bagwan on 15-07-24.

7. A room for the security guard was constructed near the college gate as proposed in previous meeting.

8. To enrich and enhance the quality in education an MOU was signed on 16/07/2024, between G.C. Badak and G.C. Nagrata Bagwan. The main aim of the MOU is to encourage mutual co-operation and assistance among the colleges for better educational & administrative management. MOU would specifically enforce an exchange of educational resources between the two colleges & assistance in research projects.

9. A placement drive was organised by the Training & Placement Cell of G.C. Nagrata Bagwan on 2 Aug. 2024. It was a matter of immense pleasure that 38 students of the college from B.Com, B.BIT & BCA got jobs at the initial package of 25 lacs, in Neek Global Multi National Billing Company.

10. Independence Day was celebrated in the College on 15th Aug. by Unfurling the National flag. The NSS & Rovers & Rangers Units participated in the ceremony.

11. To spread awareness about AIDS, a Youth Fest Marathon was organised in Dharamshala. About 20 colleges participated in the event and it was a matter of pride for Abhay Utham of G.C. Nagrata Bagwan bagged 1st position with a cash prize of 1500/-.

14. For proper and pollution free solid waste disposal, correspondence will be done with 'Environment officer' and a request will be made to the authorities of municipal Corporation Nagra-Bagwan to facilitate the institution with one garbage collection van at the gate.

15. House exams for UG courses would be conducted in the mid of December. In order to prepare the students well & to give them a secretariat experience of Univ. examination, the papers will be set as per university pattern only.

16. As proposed in the previous IQAC meeting, a small pantry unit will be installed in the staff

Agenda of the meeting was to assess the action taken on the proposals made by IQAC in the previous meeting held on 21-09-24. IQAC verified that the following actions were taken on the proposed plans:-

1. N.S.S. Day was celebrated on 24th Sept 2024. Dr. S.K. Saini graced the occasion as Chief Guest. Different competitions were organised among the volunteers in which they participated spiritedly. A one day camp was also organised on the occasion. The volunteers carried out a cleanliness drive in the campus and also rendered their services for campus beautification.
2. Raniq, a student of BA III year bagged 6th position in HP Inter College Cross Country (Women) Championship held at G.C. Haridwar, Manali. She was selected for All India Inter Univ. Cross Country Championship.

3. The Dept. of English in collaboration with Literary Club of the College organised a guest lecture on 27-9-24. 4. As proposed by IARE, a small pantry unit, along with a refrigerator, was installed in the staff room for ready arrangement of Tea/coffee etc. for the staff for other purposes.

5. A declamation competition was organised by Declamation & Quiz Mentoring Cell on 10th Oct 2024, in the Examination Hall.

6. Eco-Club along with Rovers & Rangers Unit of the College organised a Rangoli competition on 11-10-2024.

7. A one-day educational trip was organised by Dept. of Botany on 18-10-2024 to Chaudhary Sarwan Kumar Agriculture Univ., Palampur. 35 students of BSc II & BSc III visited the Univ. under the guidance and supervision of Teacher Exchange Prof. Nipavika Rana. The students visited the Natural Farming and Mushroom Cultivation units in the Univ. in which they were

provided information about organic fertilizers and different techniques used in Natural Farming and mushroom cultivation along with the knowledge about varied species of mushrooms.

8. The 38th Annual Convention of Indian Association of Physics Teachers (IAPT) was jointly organised by CUHP; NIT Hamirpur; G.D.C, Dharan Talah & G.D.C. Nagrota Bagwan, in Rainbow International School N.B. from 16th - 18th Oct 2024. About 100 students of the college attended the convention and also actively participated in pre-convention workshop on "Telescope making".

After formal oath administration Jagriti President CSCA, thanked college administration for granting her the opportunity and assured her full support and commitment for the betterment of the institution.

10. The Road Safety Club of the college organised a rally on Road Safety in the surrounding area on 26-10-24. The students spread awareness on road safety by raising slogans and through

banners and placards.

11. A session on 'Sudarshan Kriya Yoga' under 'Art of Living' was organised on 28-10-24 by the Commerce Society for students and teachers. Championship to be held in Bhubaneswar, Odisha.

15. Career Guidance & Counselling Cell along with Road Safety Club organised a workshop on Drug Deaddiction & Road safety awareness on 19-11-24. SHO, Dept of Police Sh. Chaman Kumar addressed the students on this occasion. He shared valuable information on the tremendous rise in the use of drug substances, its terrible effects and the ways to abstain from these drugs. 20. Repair & renovation work in the toilets is being carried out at a fast pace.





xv) To develop talents, learn new skills and to build confidence, Talent Hunt programme will be organised by the college from next session.









The purpose of the meeting was to assess the action taken on the proposals made by the IQAC in the last meeting held on 11-12-2024. IQAC verified that the following actions were taken on the proposed plans:-

1. Mid-term exams were successfully conducted in the mid of December. Exams were conducted in two shifts (M&E) as per Univ. pattern. To prepare the students well for the Univ. exams, full three hours, Univ. style paper was set in each subject.
2. Training & Placement Cell of the College organizes an open placement drive in the College campus.

About 10 students, including the present & the past ones, attended the interview. It was a matter of pride & delight for the institution that 49 students were finally selected for jobs. Such placement drives open up new vistas for the employment opportunities for the youth.

→ The proceedings of the meeting are as under —

Workshop on Road Safety

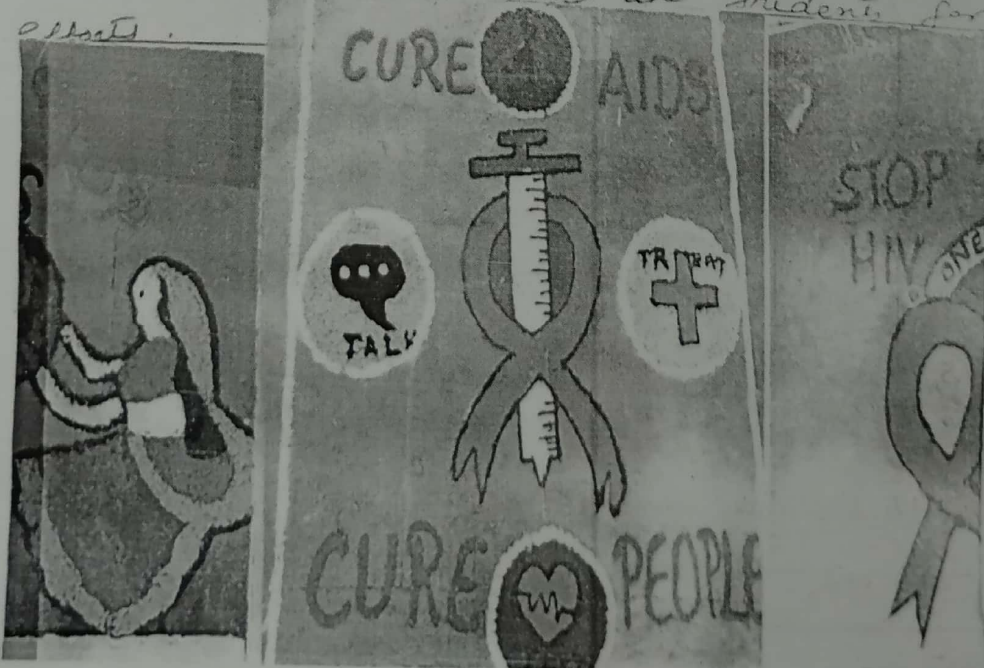


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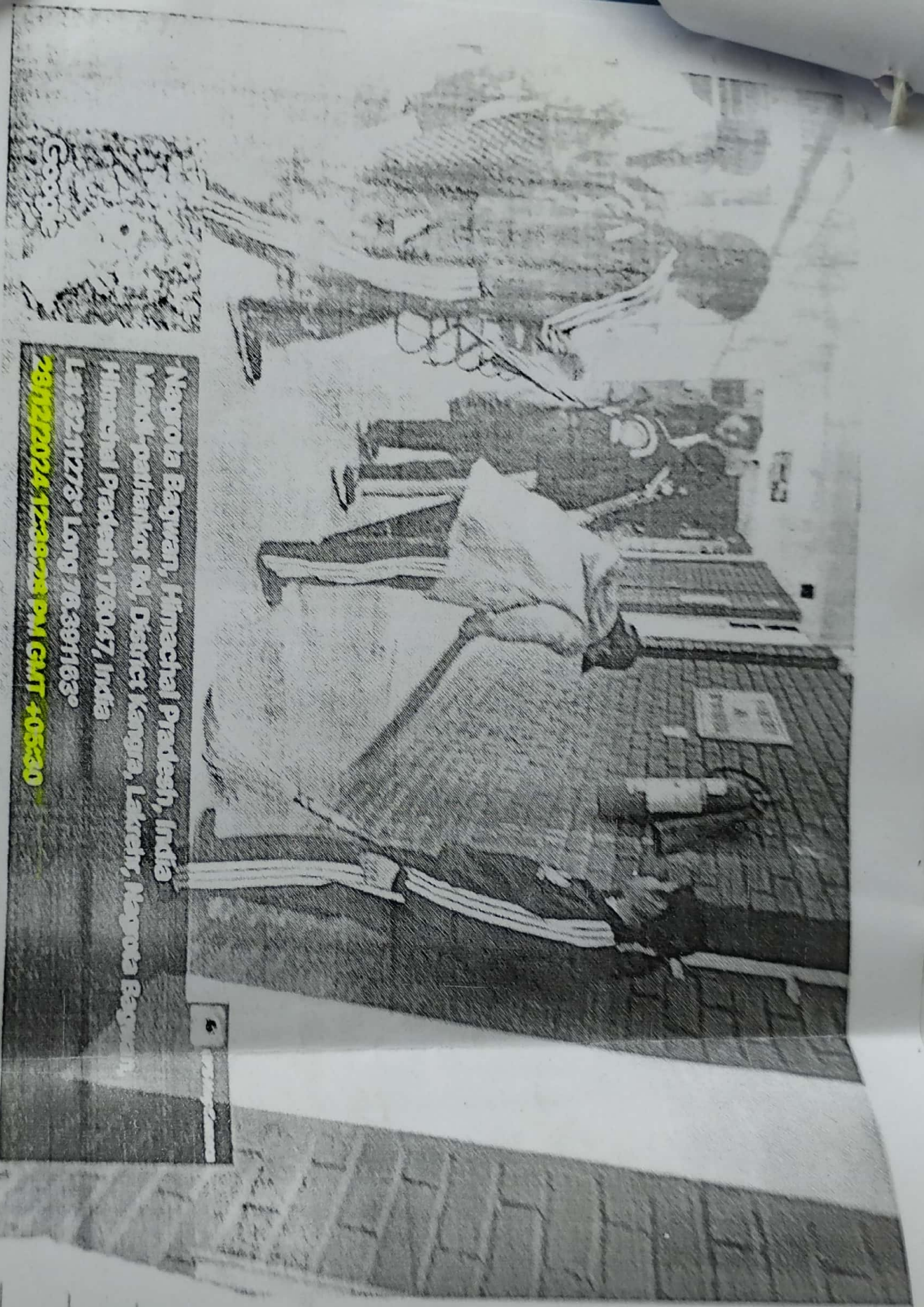
1st Day of NSS Camp

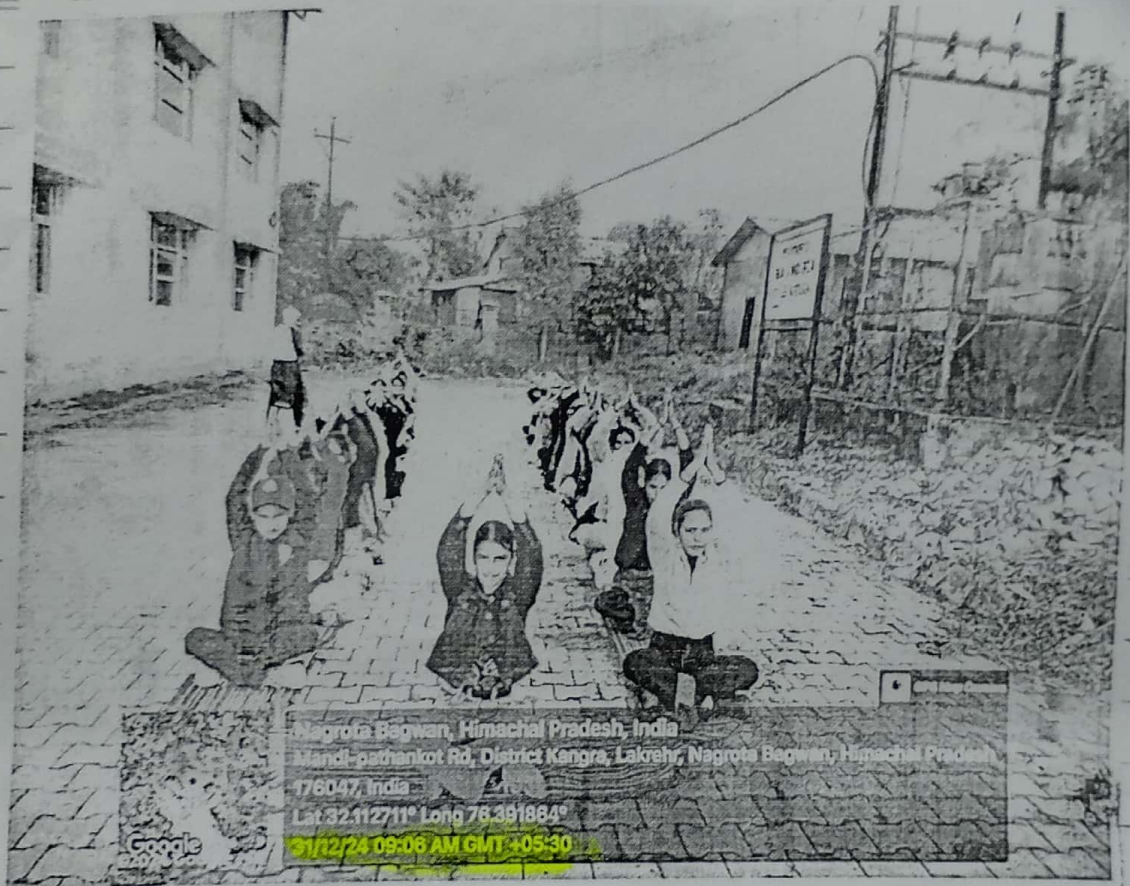
