Memorandum of Understanding

1. This Memorandum of Understanding is made on14thJune, 2024.

BETWEEN:

1.1 Govt Degree College Nagrota Bagwan

And

- 1.2 Government Degree College, Baroh District Kangra Himachal Pradesh-176047 India (herein after known as "GDC Baroh" of the Second Part.
- 1.2 1.3 Each of the GDC Baroh and Govt Degree College Nagrota Bagwan herein are referred to as 'Party' and collectively the 'Parties'.

Preamble

- 1.3 The need of close cooperation in research and academic activities between Universities and National Laboratories has been realized by the University Grants Commission, All India Council of Technical Education, Indian Council of Agricultural Research, Council of Scientific and Industrial Research and other organizations. GDC Baroh and Govt Degree College Nagrota Bagwan are interested to collaborate in various areas of activities common to these institutions. Both the, GDC Baroh and, Govt Degree College Nagrota Bagwan
- 1.4 have agreed to enter into MoU for collaborative research and academic activities of minual interest on the terms and conditions specified here in:
- 1.5 Academic and Research Cooperation between GDC Baroh and Govt Degree College Nagrota Bagwan

1.6 It is agreed that the Govt Degree College Nagrota Bagwan

will provide the faculty support in the area of collaboration in research and academic activities for Post Graduate (PG) /Under graduate (PG) programmes. It is also agreed that:

- a. GDC Baroh and Govt. Degree College Nagrota Bagwan will undertake Teaching, Training and research work in the areas of mutual interests.
- b. The concerned faculty of GDC Baroh and Govt. Degree College Nagrota Bagwan will formulate academic and research cooperation and HRD plans for joint work with
- c. Joint sponsored and consultancy projects could be undertaken, with both long term and short term goals, keeping in view the interests and academic scope of the respective institutions

Exchange / Deputation of Faculty/ Staff/ P.G. Students

- To exchange faculty/ staff for a minimum possible period (depending upon the nature of job/ work) at a time for the purpose of implementation of joint tasks within the areas of operation. Faculty/ staff members on such visits shall be deemed to be on duty within
- That the faculty/ staff, PG/UG students may visit and work in other institution for a short period in connection with their research work as per Govt, guidelines on payments basis
- iii. That the technical personnel deputed for training shall be deemed to be on duty with the parent organisation for that period of training. The TA/DA will be borne by the parent organisations.

These visits and trainings etc. would be performed with the prior approval of the

- It is agreed that the collaboration between GDC Baroh and Govt. Degree College Nagrota competent authority. Bagwanshall be established in the area of mutual interests of both the institutions for the advancement of Curricular and extra- curricular activities, basic and applied research activities which could include research and academic interests (UG/PGstudents as well as faculty/ scientists undertaking Curricular and extra- curricular , research activities in respective institutes).
- Accordingly, Faculty of GDC Baroh and Govt. Degree College Nagrota Bagwanas welling students of both the institutes working in the mutually agreed areas could freely interact with each other and should be able to undertake their research work on collaboration mode as per condition agreed at 2(ii) above.

- Govt. Degree College Nagrota Bagwanagrees to extend its R&D facilities to GDC Barot II, any, for analytical and research purposes on chargeable basis and/or on collaboration basis as per H.P. Govt. / Deptt. of Technical Education/Deptt. of Higher Education guidelines. However, specific or need based R&D projects may be taken up on case to case basis. It successful, all efforts shall be made for joint submission of project proposals for seeking research grants to meet out the expenses (consumables, manpower, travel etc.) for proposed research activities, if permitted by Govt.
- GDC Baroh also agreed to have collaboration with Govt. Degree College Nagrota Bagwanin field and extension activities. Activities for extension will be mutually decided by GDC Baroh and Govt. Degree College Nagrota Bagwanlater on.
- The results of work produced through the joint efforts of both the Organizations under the terms of this MOU and conditions agreed by both parties later on will be jointly owned.

 Disclosure of any such results to parties outside this MoU will only be done with the parties.
- Both the Organizations hereby agree that the Intellectual Property (IP)/ Publications generated as a result of work under this MoU should be protected jointly and the ownership shall largely depend on the extent of intellectual contribution made by members of each of the Organizations. The cost of filing and maintaining IPR will also be decided on the basis of extent of intellectual contribution made by members of each Organization.
- Research findings covered under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be published
 with mutual consent of joint authors of any collaborative research projects undertaken later
 on and according to normal academic practice. The publication(s) may be joint or separate as
 determined in each specific case, except in the case of annual reports.
- Participating faculty in the afore-mentioned collaboration will abide by the academic regulations of the GDC Baroh /GDC Nagrota Bagwan.
- Faculty and students will be bound by the rules and regulations of both the institutions which may be amended from time to time by Govt. or University, as the case may be.
- Joint Placement Drives: In situations, when companies desire candidates of appropriate degree (BBA, BCA at GDC Baroh and GDC Nagrota Bagwan) joint placement drive: may be conducted at suitable venue.
- The implementation and regulation of MoU shall be monitored and discussed by the
 Director, Govt. Degree College Nagrota Bagwanand Principal, GDC Baroh, and any interim
 modification/alteration as may be necessary, shall be brought into force from time to time.

• The MoU shall remain valid for a period of five years w.e.f. the date of signing and shall extendable further on mutual consent. Either of the parties can terminate the lighter within 90 days notice/information shared by either of party with other.

3. AREAS OF CO-OPERATION

The areas of cooperation will be defined and modified from time to time by the joint ordination committee set up by both the parties.

COORDINATION COMMITTEE

The following will constitute the Coordination Committee to monitor and review

- Consider the addition/deletion of areas of academic collaboration between the two Institution during review, and.
- Consider the continuation of the MoU.

In case of joint research and consultancy projects taken up by GDC Baroh and GDC 5. NON- DISCLOSURE Nagrota Bagwan, no party will disclose any investigation to media/any unauthorized pers from each institutes in any form whether electronic/print without mutual consent.

FORCE MAJEURE:

Neither of the Parties shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective obligations under this agreement due to the exigency of one or more of the Force Majeure events such as but not limited to acts of God, War, Flood, Earthquakes, Strikes, Lockouts Epidemics, Riots, Civil Commotions etc. provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such event the Party affected thereby shall give a notice in writing to the other Party within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the Force Majeure conditions continue beyond six months, the parties shall jointly decide about the future course of action.

7. SETTLEMENTS UPON TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT:

All rights granted to and the obligations undertaken by the parties hereto shall cease exist forthwith except the obligation of both the Organisations (GDC Baroh and GD Nagrota Bagwan) to keep information confidential.

All notices and other communications required to be served on the GDC Baroh under ter of this agreement, shall be considered to be duly served if the same shall have been delivered. left with or posted by registered mail to the GDC Baroh at its last known address of business Similarly, any notice to be given to the Govt. Degree College Nagrota Bagwanshall b considered as duly served if the same shall have been delivered to, left or posted by registere mail to the Govt. Degree College Nagrota Bagwanat its registered address in Nagrota Bagwanat

AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT No amendment or modifications of this agreement shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representative and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this agreement. The modifications/changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made/executed, unless otherwise agreed to:

10. ASSIGNMENTS OF THE AGREEMENT

The rights and/or liabilities arising to any of the Parties to this agreement shall not assigned except with the written consent of the other Party and subject to such terms at conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.

SEAL OF PARTIES

This MoU is valid for a period of 5 (five) years starting w.e.f. date of signing 14th June, 2024 subject to further extension on mutually agreed terms and conditions. Any midcourse change/alteration/termination as introduced/suggested by the Review Committee and duly approved by head of office of both the parties shall also be deemed to be valid for both the institutions. This MoU has been executed in two originals; one of these has been retained by Baroh and the other by GDC Nagrota Bagwan.
