

Action Taken Report

A meeting of IQAC was held on 25-04-25. It was convened by the IQAC coordinator Prof. Salil Sagar. The following members remained present in the meeting:

The meeting was convened with the intent to assess the action taken with regards to the plan of action proposed by IQAC. The committee verified that the following activities were carried out as per the IQAC proposal.

1. The Annual Examination of UG classes and the Semester examination of PG classes by both the Universities i.e. H.P.U. Shimla and S.P.U. Mandi was smoothly conducted.
2. The admission procedure for BBA and BCA was successfully carried out in the month of June. Admission to the UG classes was carried out through online mode successfully.

3. To enhance the convenience & safety of the pedestrian and to beautify the space on both sides of the pavements leading from the gate has been started to beautify by installing interlocked tile and the construction work is under process.

4. Gym upgradation work has been completed to improve the physical fitness infrastructure for the students. H'ble MLA Shri R.S. Bali had sanctioned the grant of ₹ 7.5 lakh for this purpose.

5. A reminder was sent to the Directorate seeking permission to start PGDA.

6. Recommendation was made to authorities for filling up the long lying vacant posts in the subjects of Zoology and Mathematics.

7. For modernizing campus toilet facilities and to enhance sanitation and hygiene, toilet upgradation work has already carried out in Boys' toilets. The work is to be expedited and the rest of the toilets in the building will be upgraded like wise.

8. The construction of new entrance gate will be started soon. The funds have been received from HPTDC for this purpose. This project will be helpful to enhance the aesthetic appeal and to fortify the security of the campus.

9. To facilitate cultural and extra curricular events

and to provide better academic infrastructure, and ~~to~~ a multipurpose hall will soon be constructed in the near future.

10. As a part of the larger green and eco-friendly campus initiative, the cleanliness and beautification work has been started in the near area of the College Campus. More floral trees and fruit bearing trees will be planted in this session.

11. Considering the rise in the temperature during summer, the three AC's in the College hall, one in Principal's office and two in R.N. 312 i.e. ICT lab have been installed.

12. The Prospectus Committee has uploaded the prospectus on College website for the Session 2025-26, highlighting essential features and course details.

13. A Campus Placement Drive was organised on 16-05-2025 in the College to provide job opportunities to the students. Around six companies took part in this drive with the target of 200 recruitments of ongoing students.

14. In last IQAC meeting, it was discussed that for sports-related activities and various athletic events, the College sports ground will be readied properly by clearing all sorts of wilderness, stones etc. To facilitate more viewers, the seating capacity will also be expanded soon by constructing additional cemented stairs around the ground.

15. To provide secure residential facility to the girls students coming from far-flung remote areas, the construction work of hostel has been started so that these students need not to live in rental accommodation for the purpose of their academic pursuits.
16. The under process work of College magazine for the session 2024-25 has been expedited for the timely publication of the same.
17. A letter was written to the Ex. Engineer (Electricity) requesting immediate action regarding unsafe risky condition of electric wires passing through the campus.
18. It was discussed in the last IQAC meeting that a two-day Seminar will be organised at the commencement of the new session which would be helpful to keep abreast with new pedagogical trends. The details of the seminar would be finalised after consultation with the faculty members and guest speakers.
19. Girls' Common room would be given a new look by adding new chairs and couch to create a more refreshing and pleasant space for female students.
20. As proposed in previous meetings of IQAC, the long time pending work of constructing a new imposing gate

at the College entrance has also been started.
