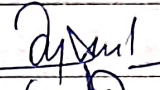
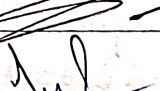


Action Taken Report.

An IQAC meeting, convened by the IQAC Coordinator Prof. Salvi Sagar, was held on 22-2-25. The following members remained present in the meeting :-

The purpose of the meeting was to assess the action taken on the proposals made by the IQAC in the last meeting held on 11-12-2024. IQAC verified that the following actions were taken on the proposed plan:-

1. Mid-term exams were successfully conducted in the mid of December. Exams were conducted in two shifts (M&E) as per Univ. pattern. To prepare the students well for the Univ. exams, full three hours, Univ. style paper was set in each subject.
2. Training & Placement Cell of the college organised an open placement drive in the college campus on 18th Dec. 2024. One of the leading firms of the nation 'Vardhman' arrived the campus for interviewing the probable candidates for job.

About 80 students, including the present & the passed^{out} ones, attended the interview. It was a matter of pride & delight for the institution that 49 students were finally selected for jobs. Such placement drives open up new vistas for the employment opportunities for the youth. Adding another feather to his cap & bringing laurels to the institution Prof. Minod Guleria, Asstt. Prof. of Sociology, bagged three medals in 13th H.P. State Master Games held at Kehlloor Sports Complex, Bilaspur on 14th & 15th Dec. Prof. Guleria set a standard by winning a gold medal in 1500 mt. & 10 km race & a silver in 5 km race. By his remarkable achievement he set an example for the other teachers as well as students to stay physically fit, energetic & optimistic & never give up hard work.

4. A special lecture on 'Moral values' was organised by the Career Counselling & Guidance Cell of the college in collaboration with Dept. of BBA. On 19th Dec. Sh. Amrish Sharma, Sai Education Trust, Dharamshala was invited as the special guest cum speaker on the occasion. Expressing his concern over the ever growing menace of drugs & wrong use of mobiles, he emphasized on the need to check the evil tendencies in teenagers. Citing examples from the lives of Holy guru Shankaracharya & Swami Vivekananda, he urged the students to follow the path of righteousness & truthfulness in life.

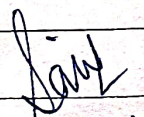

9. Seven Days Special Annual N.S.S. Camp was

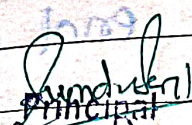
organised by the N.S.S. Unit in the college campus from 28-12-24 to 3-1-25. N.S.S.
