The following action plan was proposed by the IQAC in the meeting :-

1. The area on both sides of the pavement leading from the gate is to be beautified by installing interlocked tiles. Apart from being a step towards campus beautification, this will enhance the convenience & safety of the pedestrians. Tender process has been completed for the same.
2. To improve physical fitness infrastructure for the students gym upgradation work will be carried out. A grant of Rs. 7.5 lakh has already been sanctioned for this purpose by the H'ble MLA Sh. R.S. Bali.
3. A reminder will be sent to the Directorate seeking permission to start PG DCA.

4. Recommendation will be made to the authorities for filling up the long-lying vacant posts in the subjects of Zoology and mathematics. Lack of teachers in these departments has been causing severe academic impediment for the students.
5. For modernizing campus toilet facilities and to enhance sanitation and hygiene, toilet upgradation work is already being carried out in Boys' toilets. The work is to be expedited and the rest of the toilets in the building will also be upgraded likewise.
6. To enhance the aesthetic appeal and to fortify the security of the campus, a new entrance gate will soon be constructed from the funds received by HPTDC.
7. To provide better academic infrastructure and to facilitate cultural and extra-curricular events, a multipurpose hall cum auditorium will be constructed in the near future.
8. As a part of the larger green and eco-friendly campus initiative, the cleanliness and beautification work will be carried out in the rear area of the college building. More floral trees and fruit bearing trees will be planted there to give it a green look.

9. To provide faculty members with convenient and secure accommodation ^{facility} within the college premises, staff-residences should be built.
10. Considering the rise in the temperature during summers, it was proposed by IQAC that one AC will be installed in Principal's office, three ACs in college hall and two in R.N. 312 i.e. ICT lab.
11. To create a more refreshing and pleasant functional space for female students, Girls common room will be given a new look by adding new chairs and a couch. walls of the Common room will be made bright with posters and paintings.
12. Ongoing correspondence with a private agency for conducting Green-Energy audit of the college will be vigorously pursued. To make it a feasible reality in the next session.
13. The institution remains ever concerned for providing job opportunities to the students. In this regard once again a campus Placement drive is to be organised on 16-5-2025 in the college. Around 6 companies are expected to take part in this with an expected target of 200 recruitments of on-going students.
14. The Prospectus committee will start preparing the prospectus for the next session 2025-26, highlighting essential features & course details.

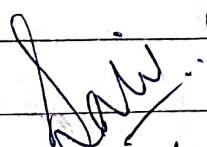

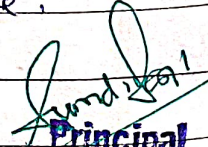
